Parking/Driving Rules & Regulations

1. Parking permit applications are due Thursday, August 27, 2009 by 3:30 p.m.
2. A waiting list will be established for students eligible for parking permits but who did not meet the August 27 deadline for submitting parking permit applications.
3. Only students who are class of 2010 or class of 2011 who have a valid driver's license will be eligible to purchase parking permits. Students with "blue slips" or with driving permits will not be eligible.
4. Only students who are class of 2010 or class of 2011 will be eligible to receive a parking permit. Students must present a current Schaumburg High School I.D. card in order to receive a parking permit.
5. Seniors (class of 2010) who met the August 27 deadline and have a valid driver's license and student I.D. must purchase a parking permit on Friday, August 28 or Monday, August 31. ***Seniors who do not purchase parking permits on these days will be put on the waiting list.***
6. Names of Juniors (class of 2011) who met the August 27 deadline will be placed in a lottery to purchase any parking permits left after the sale of permits to seniors. The lottery list will be posted outside of the Attendance office on Tuesday, September 1. Announcements will be made for juniors on the lottery list to purchase their permits Wednesday, September 2 or Thursday, September 3. Juniors whose names are picked in the lottery but do not purchase their permits by September 3 at 3:30 p.m. will not receive a parking permit for that semester. Juniors eligible for the lottery but who do not receive a permit will remain on the waiting list.
7. Parents and school authorities have the right to revoke a student's parking privilege at any time. The parking tag will be confiscated and fees forfeited for that semester.
8. The individual school is not liable for any damage, theft, injury or death that may occur as a result of a person driving to school or parking on school property.
9. Students who use a vehicle to violate any school regulation, village ordinance, state law or federal law shall lose their school driving privileges. Student vehicles are subject to search by school officials.
10. Possession and/or use of alcohol, drugs, or tobacco by any person, regardless of age, is strictly prohibited on the entire grounds of any District 211 school. This policy applies to persons in vehicles on school property as well.
11. Students shall not loiter in vehicles or parking areas.
12. Improper parking, such as parking in a reserved or no parking zone, a faculty area, aisles, or non-display of school parking tag may result in disciplinary action, loss of privileges, and the issuance of a parking citation and fine. Repeated violators may have their parking permit revoked and/or their vehicle towed at owner's expense and face school disciplinary consequences.
13. Each vehicle driven to a District 211 school must have a valid parking tag displayed. ***Students and faculty/staff must display their respective tags appropriately.*** Motorcycles must be registered as well, with sticker displayed properly.
14. The student parking tag must be hung on the rear view mirror so that the number is visible from in front of the vehicle. The student parking sticker must be displayed on the driver side of the **rear** window.
15. Student parking is restricted to parking spaces which do not have a white line across the entrance to the parking space. Staff parking is indicated by a white line across the entrance to the parking space.
16. The school is not responsible for lost or stolen parking tags. Parking stickers or tags which are **LOST OR STOLEN** will **NOT** be replaced. New vehicle purchases must be reported to the attendance office with the new vehicle information.
17. There will be no refund of the student parking user fee for the current semester. There will be no temporary or emergency tags/stickers issued.
18. Students may purchase only one parking tag per semester.
19. Parking tags/stickers issued beginning August 28 are valid for 1st semester only. Parking tag/stickers for second semester, 2010, must be displayed beginning Tuesday, January 26, 2010. Parking tags/stickers for first semester will be void beginning Tuesday, January 26, 2010.
20. Parking stickers or tags are non-transferable and cannot be sold or given to another individual.
21. The opportunity to purchase and utilize a parking permit on campus is a privilege. ***A student's pass will be revoked for attendance and discipline reasons without a refund.***
